

Livestream Options

Below are livestream options that I would recommend. There are many other options to livestream (e.g., you can use a computer with tools like OBS studio and a capture card – this may save you some money, but does increase the complexity), but below are the options I have been successful with. The quality of your stream will be based mostly on the quality of your internet connection (ethernet preferred with a 5 mbps upload speed).


Minimum Option (single camera)

- Computer with internet access (5 mbps upload)
- Web camera (USB) – minimum 720p, preferred 1080p quality
 - Should include audio
- YouTube Channel



Multi-Camera Option on WiFi

- Computer with internet access
- ATEM MiniPro
- Camera(s) with HDMI clean out



Multi-Camera Option on Ethernet

- ATEM MiniPro direct connection to internet via Ethernet
- Camera(s) with HDMI clean out
- Note: You will need a computer to name the stream and start it – this does not need to be connected to the ATEM. You may also be able to do this on a tablet or iPad.
